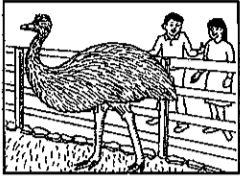

Ms Woods : I like proverbs. They are full of wisdom. They also give us advice and tell us something about our life. In some proverbs, the same idea is expressed in both English and Japanese. [(1)], when we want to say that time passes quickly, we say, "Time flies."
